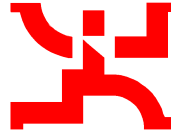

## 2: COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Composition: Styrene / acrylic copolymer, inorganic fillers, pigment, surfactant, water.

This product contains ingredients classified as hazardous. However, they are NOT present in sufficient quantities to warrant classifying the product as hazardous.

All constituents of this product are listed in EINECS (European Inventory of Existing Commercial Chemical Substances) or ELINCS (European List of New Chemical Substances) or are exempt.

## 3: HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

No significant hazard.

## 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

Eyes: Irrigate immediately with copious quantities of water for several minutes. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water or suitable skin cleanser as soon as possible.

Inhalation: Remove from exposure - unlikely to occur.

Ingestion: Wash out mouth with water and give sips of cold water to soothe the affected parts. Obtain medical attention.

## 5: FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Suitable Extinguishing Media: Carbon dioxide, powder, foam or water fog - Do not use water jets.

Special Exposure Hazards: Toxic fumes. For further information see Section 10.

Special Protective Equipment: Self-contained breathing apparatus.

## 6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal Precautions: Wear suitable protective clothing, gloves and eye/face protection.

Environmental Precautions: Prevent entry into drains, sewers and water courses.

Decontamination Procedures: Soak up with inert absorbent or contain and remove by best available means. Gather into containers.

## 7: HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling: Avoid skin and eye contact.

Storage: Store in cool, dry area. Protect from frost.

## 8: EXPOSURE CONTROLS/PERSONAL PROTECTION

Occupational Exposure Limits:- None assigned

Engineering Control Measures: No specific ventilation requirement noted.

Personal Protective Equipment: When mist occurs during spraying operations, wear suitable respiratory protective equipment. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wear impervious gloves (eg of PVC), in case of repeated or prolonged contact. Goggles.
